Seagull?</p>	<p>7 Go for a walk and collect small rocks / pebbles / shells and paint them</p> <p>You could make these into dominos!</p>	<p>8 Play hide and seek</p> <p>Why not try when dark with torches. Each person caught in a torch beam takes over the role of the seeker.</p>
<p>9 Roll down a grassy hill</p> <p>You could race your friends.</p> <p>Watch out for dog poo!</p> 	<p>10 Play I-spy</p> <p>Using the letters from PLAYDAY</p>	<p>11 Make paper planes</p> <p>See which flies the farthest!</p>	<p>12 Build a den</p> <p>You can do this indoors or outdoors.</p>	<p>13 Go camping</p> <p>This can be done indoors or in your garden.</p>

Use a cotton bud to write on white paper. Leave to dry. To read place near light bulb.</p>	<p>16 Be an Inventor</p> <p>What can you make out of boxes, sticks and scraps of materials?</p>	<p>17 Draw and play and a game of hop scotch</p> <p>Use a stone or empty shoe polish tin as the thrower.</p>	<p>18 Night bowling</p> <p>10 plastic bottles same size, fill water and pop in glow stick.</p> <p>Great family fun!</p> 
<p>19 Chalk fun</p> <p>Get your friend to lie on the ground and draw round them – you can then add a smiley face!</p>	<p>20 Frisbee Fun</p> <p>How far you throw it?</p> <p>How many times can you and friends pass it before it drops!</p>	<p>21 Skipping fun</p> <p>How many skips can you do without stopping?</p> 	<p>22 Squirt gun painting</p> <p>Pin white paper on a wall, tree on place on ground... now paint!</p>	<p>23 Make a mud pie</p> <p>You can use empty cartons to make different shapes and sizes.</p>

Wait for the stars to come out – how many can you count?</p>	<p>25 Ice cube race</p> <p>Make and freeze ice cubes – add food colouring and have 4 of each colour. Then see who can melt their ice cubes the fastest.</p>	<p>26 Have a really loud music festival</p> <p>Use pots and pans and wooden spoons for drums!</p>	<p>27 Catch</p> <p>Place a shower cap on your head and cover this with shaving foam. See how many wotsits you can throw on your friends head.</p> 	<p>28 Water balloon fun</p> <p>Have a water balloon fight with your friends and family.</p>
